

PART 2 *Please Note: Diagrams are not to scale. All Seams should be an accurate ¼" unless indicated otherwise.*

Combining them at random, sew **ALL** of your Light 2½" x 4½" Fabric A rectangles right sides together with **ALL** of your **Medium/Dark 2½" x 4½" Fabric C rectangles**. Press seams toward your Medium/Dark rectangles.

NOTE: **IF** you are working with 2 ½" by WOF strips (a.k.a. Jelly Rolls), you may sew the strips in pairs (Lights + Mediums/Darks) along their long edge and THEN cut them apart. For the best mixture of fabrics, though, we suggest snipping the WOF strips in half so you are working with (about) 22" long pieces, and THEN sew & cut them apart.

You should end up with the following quantities:

- For the Crib size: TWENTY-FOUR (24)
- For the Nap size: EIGHTY (80)
- For the Twin size: ONE HUNDRED FORTY (140)
- For the Queen size: TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY-EIGHT (288)



Each unit should now measure 4 ½" square from raw edge to raw edge.
